The Glass Museum, located in the Palazzo Giustinian, holds samples of glass from Egyptian times through to the present day, with its displays showing how the art and manufacture of glass developed over the centuries.</i></p> <p><i>Burano is located just north of Venice. The island is known throughout the world for its specialty: Burano lace. Burano's colorful houses were painted brilliant colors out of the fishermen's desire to see their own houses from far out at sea.</i></p> <p><i>Torcello, the third Island you will visit is absolutely charming. A legend states that St. Mark stopped here while on his journey to Aquilea. The Cathedral of Santa Maria Assunta is considered a Byzantine masterpiece with its mosaic floor.</i></p>

Upon arrival at the Marina Grande you will take the Funicular to Capri. From here you will be met with a private car and visit the highest point on the Island for a panoramic view. Continue to Anacapri where you will see the fabulous Villa of Dr. Axel Munthe, a Swedish doctor, whose best selling book "Story of San Michele" tells of his time on Capri. His villa was built with the remains of Roman ruins. There is a beautiful shady garden with a terrace offering a splendid view of the island. Return back down to Capri, which is very chic with shops, hotels and restaurants lining the winding streets. In the main square, Piazza Umberto, there is a pretty white church and several open-air cafes where you can sit and watch the world drift by.</i>	<i>Return to Sorrento by hydrofoil.</i>

# Milan and Lake Como in Style

<b>DAY 1</b>	<b>Milan</b>	Upon arrival at the Milan airport ,you will be greeted by our representative outside of the arrivals hall. You will be escorted to your private car and driver for your transfer to your luxury accommodations in Milan.	<b>Balance of the day free to enjoy on your own.</b>

The Duomo, Milan's cathedral, one of the largest churches in the world, is a surprisingly elegant mass of marble boasting 135 spires and 3,400 statues. The building began life as a Gothic cathedral, but over the centuries, the designs went through several modifications, and the finished Duomo is a strange mixture of styles. Your guide will take you through the church and right up to the roof, from which you can enjoy an up close look at the building's unique architecture and incredible views of the city. From the Duomo, you will continue to the Galleria: Milan's famous shopping arcade that features the biggest names in fashion.	
<b>DAY 3</b>	<b>Milan</b>	<b>A free day for shopping or sightseeing on your own.</b>	
<b>DAY 4</b>	<b>Milan to Como</b>	After breakfast and check out from your hotel you will be transferred by private car to Lake Como, a jewel-like oasis of tranquility combining lush Mediterranean foliage and snowy alpine peaks.

<b>DAY 6</b>	<b>Lugano, Como</b>	Your driver will pick you up from the hotel for your full day excursion to Canton of Ticino and Lake Lugano, Switzerland. You will visit the towns of Lugano, Locarno and Lake Maggiore. Ticino is Switzerland's only Italian speaking Canton. The areas around its two lakes, Lago di Lugano and Lago Maggiore, enjoy a distinct Mediterranean climate where palms and citrus trees grow; figs, olives and vineyards are cultivated, and other tropical vegetation flourishes. The architecture throughout Ticino is Renaissance and Baroque, and the atmosphere is very Italian. Your first stop will be Lugano with its winding cobblestone streets and great shopping areas. Continue to Locarno and its famous Piazza Grande where locals and tourists mingle in its wonderful cafes and restaurants. Then it's on to the heart of the lake district and the glacial lake Maggiore.	<b>After your scenic day of sightseeing, return to your accommodations in Como.</b>
